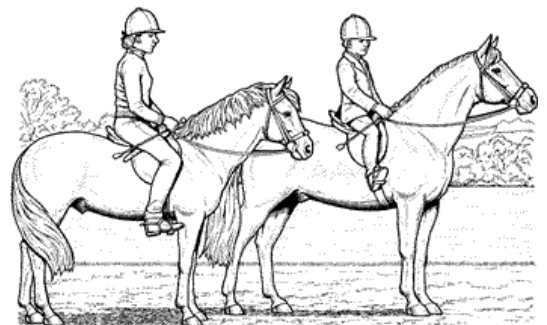

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The organisers/committee of the Margaret River & Districts Horseman's Association & Pony Club Inc. reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event/s they may deem necessary on the day especially if entries do not support a class.
- This event is run under EFA and SHC rules and regulations. All riders must be aware of the relevant rules and regulations applicable to their events.
- All entrants who are not a direct member of the EFA or an EFA insured club must pay a day fee of \$25.00 per person to cover them for insurance for this event.
- All persons on horseback are required to wear the recognised standards approved helmet and boots, as a condition of entry.
- Proof of height may be requested.
- Rider's age will be as at the day of the event. Junior rider birth certificate copies must be sighted on the day or a copy sent with entry.
- **Ponies 14h and under to be ridden by a rider not exceeding 17 years of age, except in the specified Open classes where the pony may be ridden by a rider over 17 years of age.**
- Riders under 18 are not permitted to ride in top boots or gaiters/chappettes in rider classes
- Novice – horse/pony that has not won more than three (3) first placings at an official fixture. (Ag Shows are included in this are they are official fixtures)
- Ponies/Hacks must be ridden in Championship Events by the rider that qualified them.
- Adults riding Open Ponies are only eligible for the Open Pony Championship from the qualifying events specified.
- **Pony Club classes must be ridden in FULL FORMAL pony club uniform. The club respectfully requests that official riders do not compete in the Pony Club classes; these are for riders just beginning their hacking career.**
- Handlers for Leading Rein classes must be 18 years and over. Pony is to be led from the back of a cavesson with a leather lead approximately 1.5m in length and no chain.
- Any rider/pony combinations that compete in the Leading Rein or First Ridden classes are not eligible to compete in the other classes.
- Stallions are not permitted in Show Horse classes.
- The judges' decisions are final. Under no circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the arena/ring permitted. Failure to abide by this rule will lead to disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.
- **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS. YOU WILL BE ASKED TO REMOVE THEM.**
- Canteen will be operating on the day.
- All riders must pay the mandatory \$5.00 Ambulance Levy for the day.
- The Margaret River & Districts Horseman's Association & Pony Club Inc. do not accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to grounds is at your own risk and the "Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement" form or "Non-Member Waiver of Liability" form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.

There is a significant risk that serious **INJURY** or **DEATH** may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of The Equestrian Federation of Australia and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I **voluntarily PARTICIPATE** at my **OWN RISK** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.
